

ARTICLE VIII
AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS AND CONSTITUTION OF
FAITH FELLOWSHIP CHURCH OF KINSTON,NC

AMENDMENT NUMBER 3:

USE OF CHURCH PROPERTY

- 1. The Deacon in charge of property shall approve use or removal of any equipment or furnishings from Faith Fellowship property.**
2. Building use is free to all church members.
 - a. Any person desiring the building for birthday parties, anniversary parties, showers, etc. should contact the church secretary to assure a place on the church calendar.**
 - b. Scheduling weddings should be done by contacting the Senior Pastor.**
 - c. Each event should have one contact person responsible to oversee the gathering.
 - d. It will be the responsibility of this member to see that the church building is left in the condition in which it was found.
 - e. It is the responsibility of this member to see that all church doors are locked upon leaving and trash is placed in receptacles.
3. Building use is free to non-church members in the following cases:
 - a. Small weddings with less than 25 people in attendance at the discretion of the Senior Pastor.
 - b. Baptisms. This should be scheduled by the officiating Pastor.
4. Absolute prohibitions pertaining to every person using the building:
 - a. Weddings or funerals outside the Christian faith will not be allowed.
 - b. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on church property.
 - c. Nothing may be nailed to anything in the church.**
 - d. Nothing may be taped to a wall or pew.**
 - e. Photographers and videographers may not position themselves in the baptistery or the pulpit.
 - f. A photograph that involves flash equipment will not be allowed in any service.
 - g. Any candles used for a wedding should be of the drip-less variety.
 - h. We Believe as God stated in Genesis 2 and as the Lord Jesus Christ answered the Pharisees in Matthew 19:4-5 “ the at the beginning the Creator made them male and female”. This is where marriage is sanctioned by God. This is where Holy Scripture exclusively defines marriage as being the joining of one man and one woman. Faith Fellowship will not perform marriages outside these parameters.
5. All activities not mentioned above (including the use of the church by non-members) will be reviewed by the Leadership Team on an individual basis.

This amendment is approved on November 25, 2015 by the congregation.
