SALVATION

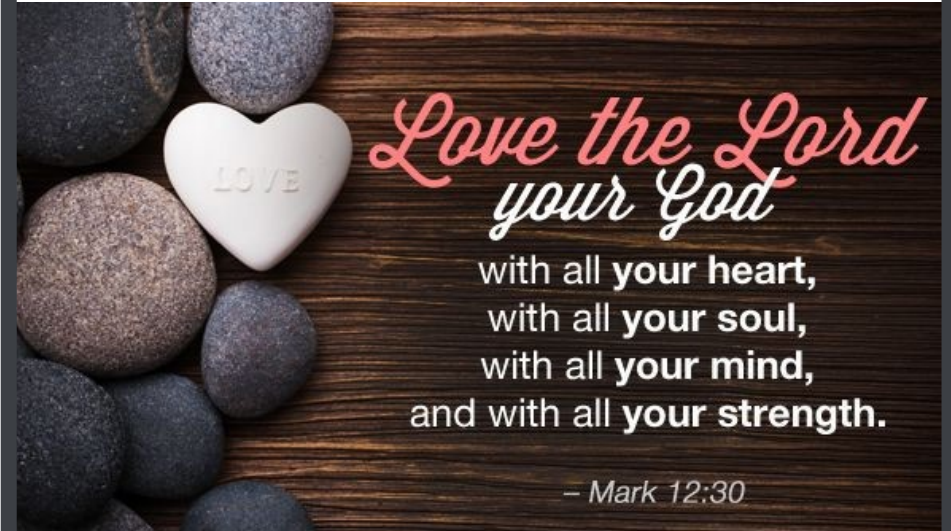
We Believe...
