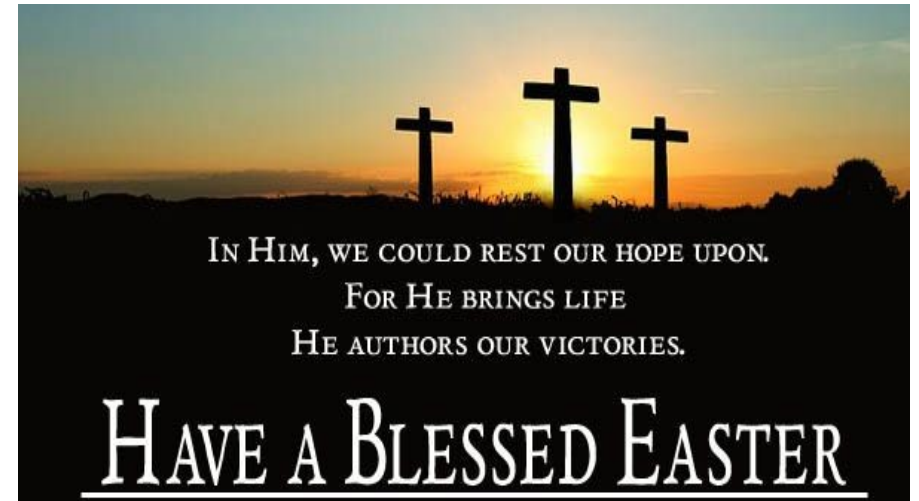

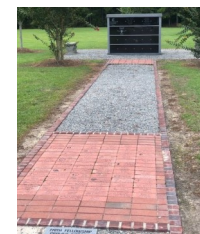


Van Ministry
