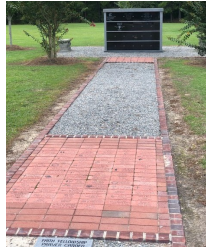


If you have been planning to order a brick ...

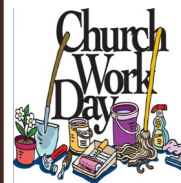
Sanctuary Flowers
